New releases

There have been announced several new releases for the second quarter. Really spectacular is the new figurine of Gaston and the Village Girls. These figurines will be available for members only and can be ordered at your dealer with the Redemption Certificates (which will probably be sent with the Sketches of May).



This year Disneyland celebrates it's 50th anniversary and in honour of this occasion there will be released two special figurines. Enesco has made some information available on one of these sculptures: Walt Disney and Mickey at Walt's desk will be the addition to the collection. Enesco lowers European WDCC prices

Enesco has lowered their prices for several non-retired figurines: this has been done because of the weak dollar and strong euro. The new prices have been added to the website. There are several series with a lot of price changes, for example The Aristocats, It's a Small World, The Nightmare before Christmas and Beauty and the Beast.

Higher prices retired sculptures and insurance



The prices of some of the retired sculptures have risen: in particular the price of Prince John and Sir Hiss, the Members Only set of 2004, will become much higher with the current demand (the issue price was € 345,-). Also, the Magic Mirror, the event piece of March 2005, will increase it's value when the stock of the dealers has been depleted.
